Dance B.A.: Courses suggested (not required) for major: One course each in improvisation/choreography (Dance 170, 171A or 271A), dance history and theory (Dance 103), and coursework focusing on dance as a medium to connect and engage the community. Eight courses in various dance techniques particularly Modern/Postmodern dance (Dance 130A or 230A), Hip-Hop (Dance 162), West-African (Dance 165 or 265) or Ballet (Dance 120A or 220A).

*Dance applicants must audition, in addition to showing strong academic preparation and involvement in the arts and community that demonstrates interests in varied cultures. More information may be found at www.arts.ucla.edu/apply. Dance will also consider sophomore transfers, see website.

<u>USC</u>

Dance B.F.A: Transfer students are welcome to apply for admission to USC Kaufman's BFA in dance with the understanding that the program takes a full 4 years to complete.

Transferable dance courses taken at ECC will yield general elective credit. Transferable non-dance courses may satisfy USC General Education requirements (See USC GE pattern).

Dance B.F.A: At CalArts, the year-level at which a student begins (BFA 1, BFA 2, etc.) is based on the level of work presented in the portfolio/audition as determined by a review from a faculty committee.

It is suggested (not required) that transfer students complete courses from the Critical Studies requirement. One course from each of the following areas: <u>Humanities</u> (Engl 1B, Engl 1C, Humanities 1, Phil 103); <u>Social Science</u> (Hist 101, Hist 102, Pol Sci 1, Psych 5, Socio 101); <u>Science & Math</u> (Math 130, Math 150, Astr 20, Bio 10, Chem 20, Geology1); <u>Cultural Studies</u> (Anthro 2, Womens Studies 1, Coms 120, Ethnic Studies 1 or 3).
