 - Up to 100 hours of training
- Registration into ECC Co-operative ed course
 - 1 unit of credit for participation with the employer
- Placement in areas of Aerospace Composites
 - Mentorship in areas of Aerospace Composites fabrication, repair, and inspection.



Employer Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a current/past El Camino College student
- 18 years of age or older
- In good academic standing with a minimum 2.0 Grade Point Average
- U.S. citizenship documentation is required for clearance by the employer (if selected)
- Complete and submit:

- Attend an interview (if selected)
- Register for a winter co-op education course at El Camino College
