



Campus Watch - Burglary

On April 28, 2023 at 6:48 p.m. an unknown trouble was reported at the Cashiers Office. Officers were dispatched to the scene. The dispatch camera observed a male adult 18 -25 years old, 5'10' to 6' tall, thin build with short hair in twists or braid-style wearing a black scarf, black long sleeve shirt, black jeans and white "Nike" brand shoes with a black "Nike" symbol leaving the area of the Cashiers Office shortly after the incident was reported. The subject was last seen walking past the lockers heading north east and disappeared from camera view.

According to officer reports, the Cashiers Office main doors were damaged, cashiers drawers ransacked, and the vault door lock was broken. It is unknown if anything was taken at this time.

El Camino College Police Department Recommendations For Your Safety

- Trust your instincts. If you feel unsafe or uncomfortable in any situation or location, go with your gut – it probably isn't the best place to be.
- In the event of an attack, get to a safe place, contact law enforcement immediately, preserve any evidence, and consider the resources available to you through the college, many of which can be found at: www.elcamino.edu/departments/title-ix-diversity-and-inclusion/resources.aspx
- If you see something, say something. By working together we all contribute to the safety of our campus.
- In an emergency, contact Campus Police by calling 911 from a landline phone, 310-660-3100 from a cell phone, or use a campus "Code Blue" emergency phone.
- Have keys in hand before walking to your car.
- Always be aware of your surroundings. Remember the use cell phones may significantly distract you.
- Don't walk alone. Use the buddy system.
- Use ECC Courtesy Shuttle operated by ECC Police; on-call 24 hours. Use one of the police phones located throughout campus or call 310-660-3100.
- Night students and faculty are encouraged to park in the same general area as other faculty or students with night classes in their building. This provides the opportunity for a group of students and faculty to walk together to their cars after dark.
- Immediately report any suspicious activity to campus police.
- Be alert! Be prepared!
