Congratulations Class of 2024! You've reached an incredible milestone, and we can't wait to celebrate with you!




The EOPS Program will be hosting preceremony activities on Friday, June 7th outside of the Marsee Auditorium:

### **CARE Meal and Transportation Cards**


The CARE office will provide meal and gas/bus pass assistance! You are eligible to receive these services after each of your **THREE** required contacts.
