Students **MUST** log on to Canvas on the first day of class and follow any instructions to avoid being dropped.

CLASS TYPE INFORMATION:

"**CAMPUS**" classes are held on campus.

"**ONLINE**" classes have no scheduled on campus or online sessions. Time/Day is therefore not applicable (N/A).

"**LIVEO**" classes are held with weekly regular online sessions and no on campus sessions.

"**HYBRID**" classes have a mixture of weekly regular on campus sessions and online course work.

"**HYFLEX**" classes are offered on campus and online at the same time (students can attend either).

*Satisfies Area 4 of the IGETC credit, HTP, and TAP. However, it does not satisfy the minimum transfer requirements for CSU oral communication requirements.

**Courses without an "H" will have "T" designation on transcript and do count for HTP, TAP and IGETC credit.

***STEM sections designated for science majors in HTP.

IMPORTANT PROGRAM INFORMATION ON OTHER SIDE

IMPORTANT HTP POLICIES

All honors (H) courses taken before 2019 will still be considered fully transferable HTP courses with respect to TAP Certification and HTP Completion Forms. However, students should check with a counselor to make sure they are still IGETC certified.

Honors courses without an "H" (but are offered/designated as honors) will have a "T" designation on the transcript. These courses do count for HTP, TAP and IGETC credit.

HTP students must complete **at least one** honors course each semester, for a total of **five** honors courses to complete the program. ***Only two honors courses can be taken in the final (usually Spring) semester of the program.*** Students should meet with a counselor to ensure that they take the appropriate courses for their major and transfer institution.

While HTP students **must** take an honors course in the Fall and Spring semesters, Summer and Winter sessions are optional. Students who take an extra honors course in the Fall or Spring (2 or more), or take an honors course during Winter or Summer sessions, may "rollover" that course to fulfill the requirement for the subsequent semester. Refer to the HTP website on "How to Rollover an Honors Course." **Course Rollover Forms must be submitted during Weeks 1-3 of the semester. Forms submitted after Week 3 will not be considered.**

ENGLISH C1000

New HTP students are **required** to take English C1000 (formerly English 1A) during their first semester in the program, **unless** English C1000 has already been completed or has been waived by an AP exam. Taking the honors version of the course (English C1000H) is recommended.

The HTP currently offers three English courses, three History courses, and four Communication Studies courses. However, **no more than two courses in the same IGETC area may count toward the five honors courses required to complete the program.**

CONTRACTS

HTP is NOT a contract program. Students cannot make arrangements to receive honors credit in a course/section that is not designated as honors. However, certain students who also participate in First Year Experience (FYE) and/or PUENTE programs may establish contracts between faculty for dual credit in certain **English** classes since these students must take a designated honors course each semester. **Unless** HTP students are currently participating in FYE and/or PUENTE, **contracts are not an option. A maximum of two contracted courses may count toward the five honors courses requirement.**
