- Artificial Intelligence Fraudulent Students
 - There has been a significant increase in fraudulent students enrolling in ECC courses. The dean has been monitoring enrollment of all BSS departments.
 - The dean recommends creating an assignment that can't be answered by AI or a BOT that is required to stay enrolled and helps weed out fraudulent students.
 - Send a list of the fraudulent students you dropped with their name, email and student id, to the financial aid office (eccfaid@elcamino.edu).

- Drop any students as No Show if they do not participate. Any student dropped by mistake can be reinstated.
- If you find a fraudulent student after No Shows have been filed, submit a <u>Maxient</u> form and select "suspected fraud" as the reason for the report. It will go to Student Development, Financial Aid and Admissions & Records. You can submit multiple students on one Maxient report. This will trigger the student discipline process which can lead to the withdrawal of the student(s) from your course.

II) Scheduling and Enrollment

- Average of 30 sections offered Fall 2020-Fall 2023
 - Fill rates have increased slightly from Fall 2022 to Fall 2023
 - Seats filled 1,095 overall 86% fill rate
 - Online sections have higher fill rates then other modalities
- Discussed future schedule options
 - o Benefits of linking ANTH 1 and ANTH 5 sections
 - o Increase the number of short terms sections
- Department voted to open all course to high school students. Only ANTH Honors courses will have limited approval.

III) Student Success and Gap Data

- Success rates have increased from 63.6% in 2021-22 to 71.4% in 2022-23
- Asian American and White students have remained above the average success rate.
 - Asian American Students dropped in Spring 2022 but had a significant increase in Spring 2023.
 - White student's success rate have remained above average with a increase in Spring 2023.
- The Spring 2023 success rates of Latinx students dropped slightly below average success rate.
- Success rates for African American students is -9.2 Spring 2023 a decrease from Spring 2022 -14.1

- The Museum Studies courses Anthro 20 has been reactivated and will be offered in Spring 2024.
- Discussed advising students ANTH 5 Online is not accepted by USC as a lab.
- Discussed linking a section of ANTH 5 with a section of ANTH 1.

- Rodolfo will reach out to the department re: assessment. Spring assessment is due the end of the third week.



Artificial Intelligence and Fraudulent Students

- Create an assignment that can't be answered by AI or a BOT that is required to stay enrolled and helps weed
 out fraudulent students. The Distance Education Office recommends requiring a student to post a short
 introductory video or audio post or using an interaction on Pronto.
- Drop students as No Shows who do not complete the assignment, or do not complete it in the required format.
- You can always reinstate a student who is mistakenly dropped.
- Send a list of the fraudulent students you dropped with their name, email and student id, to the financial aid
 office (eccfaid@elcamino.edu).
- If you find a fraudulent student after No Shows have been filed, submit a Maxient form and select "suspected fraud" as the reason for the report. It will go to Student Development, Financial Aid and Admissions & Records. You can submit multiple students on one Maxient report. This will trigger the student discipline process which can lead to the withdrawal of the student(s) from your course.

Total Sections – 29 sections Seats Filled - 987 Overall Fill Rate – 85% fill rate


Online – 20 sections, 93% fill On Campus – 5 sections, 67% fill Hybrid – 4 sections, 71% fill

Total Sections – 31 sections Seats Filled – 1,095 Overall Fill Rate – 86% fill rate


Online – 19 sections, 94% fill rate On Campus – 7 sections, 76% fill Hybrid – 5 sections, 68% fill

Fall 2022 – Week Two Snapshot




Anthropology – Success Rates, Spring
