
ABOUT EL CAMINO COLLEGE

Part-time faculty are compensated on a semester basis according to the number of class hours assigned per semester and on cumulative semesters of instruction for the District. The beginning rate is \$90.97 - \$116.13 (lecture/extensive lab), per hour depending on education and experience.

This is a part-time, temporary position for the 2023 spring semester, beginning February 2023. Assignments may include off-site locations. A teaching demonstration and sample syllabus and assignments will be required during the interview process. 



Annual Plan - Orion




