I) New Social Sciences Building

- The opening for the new building is tentatively scheduled for September 1, 2023.
- It is possible we will begin moving offices in the Fall 2023 semester.
- ESTU classes will be scheduled in a large multimodal classroom (see slide 7 for diagram). This room is accessible from outside and can be used as a meeting space for ESTU students.
- Winter 2024 will be in new building if opening stays on schedule.
- Division council will vote on FT office selection process.

II) BSS Counselor – Robert Williams

- BSS Meta Major counselor announced campus events (slides 8-11):
 - Please see PP Slide #9 for the counselor's announcements for the Transfer Center drop in hours
 - Chat with a Counselor scheduled for every first Tuesday of the month during Spring 2023. **Location:** Between South Gym and Social Science Building.
 - Spring University Fair scheduled for Thursday, March 23rd.
 - Scheduling Counseling Appointments: Appointment can be schedule online. Drop in counseling is available in the SSVc building Tuesdays: 12-1pm SSVc 272 and Thursdays: 12:30-1:30pm SSVc 252.

III) Spring Schedule and Enrollment (PowerPoint Slides 12-15)

- Number of ESTU sections offered has steadily increased from 2020 to 2023.
 - ESTU 1 increased by 9 sections from Spring 2020 to Spring 2023

- There is a growing demand for Introduction to Social Justice Studies.
- Discussed ESTU 5 appeal to meet CSU Area F requirements.
 - Appeal has been submitted waiting on results.
- Enrollment for online ESTU sections stayed at 95% for spring 2022 and spring 2023. Fill rates for on campus classes are low. The dean will be adjusting Fall 2023 schedule. See slide #13 for enrollment by modality.
- Enrollment for online SSCI sections had a slight increase from Spring 2022 81% to Spring 2023 82%
- Future schedules will be built based on student demand.
 - Mixed modality schedule to fit into all student schedules.

IV) Student Success and Gap Data (PowerPoint Slides 16-22)

- The overall decline of success rates from Fall 2019-2022 reflects trends across the division.
- Professor Herrera noted success rates were impacted by the switch to online during 2020
- Discussed ways to increase success rate for students. How can we as a department meet student needs?
 - Recommend instructors teaching SSCI 101 meet to discuss low success rates.
- A small number for ESTU AAs were awarded in 2021-2022. The dean recommended looking into developing an AAT. The addition of the AAT would increase the number of degrees awarded.

V) Curriculum and SLOs

- Curriculum – SSCI 103H has been submitted as a new course (can be offered as an honors course with notation in the catalog before we can offer 103H in Fall 2024)
- Overdue Fall 2021 SLOs
 - ESTU 1 SLO 1
 - ESTU 3 SLO 1
 - ESTU 5 SLO 1
 - SSCI 103 SLO 1 (Omar Gonzales initially did not have access to Nuventive)

VI) ESTU GE Requirements – High School, CCCs, CSUs, UCs

- High school students starting in 2026 will be required to take one Ethnic Studies course.
- Beginning Fall 2024 1 – 3 unit ESTU course will be required for all Associate degrees
- CSU ESTU requirement already implemented as Area F
- USC ESTU requirement will be Area 7 of CalGETC, which is replacing IGETC

VII) Study Abroad – Madrid, Summer 2023

- The summer 2023 trip is fully booked with 34 students and a full waitlist.
- Waitlisted students will be prioritized for summer 2024 trip.
- Looking into the adding a second Madrid group or trip to another location.

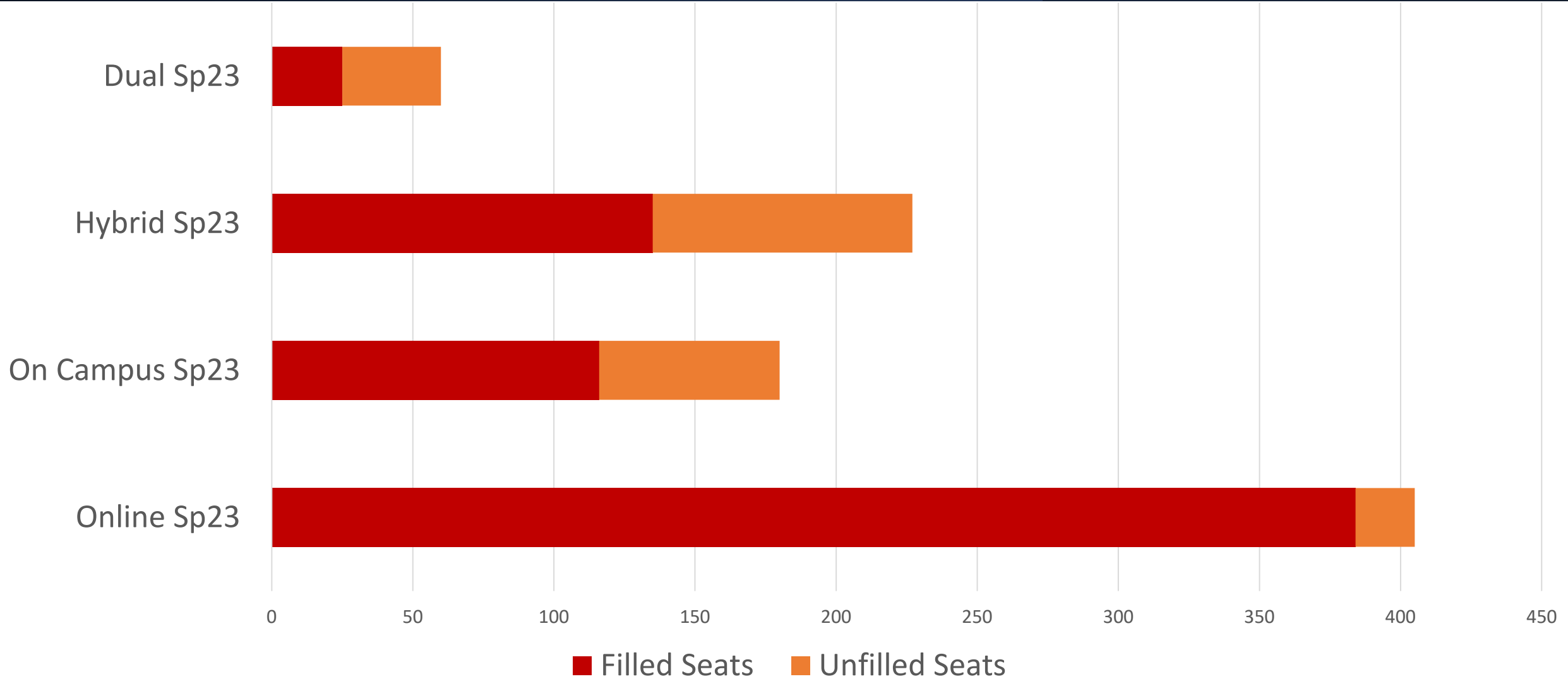

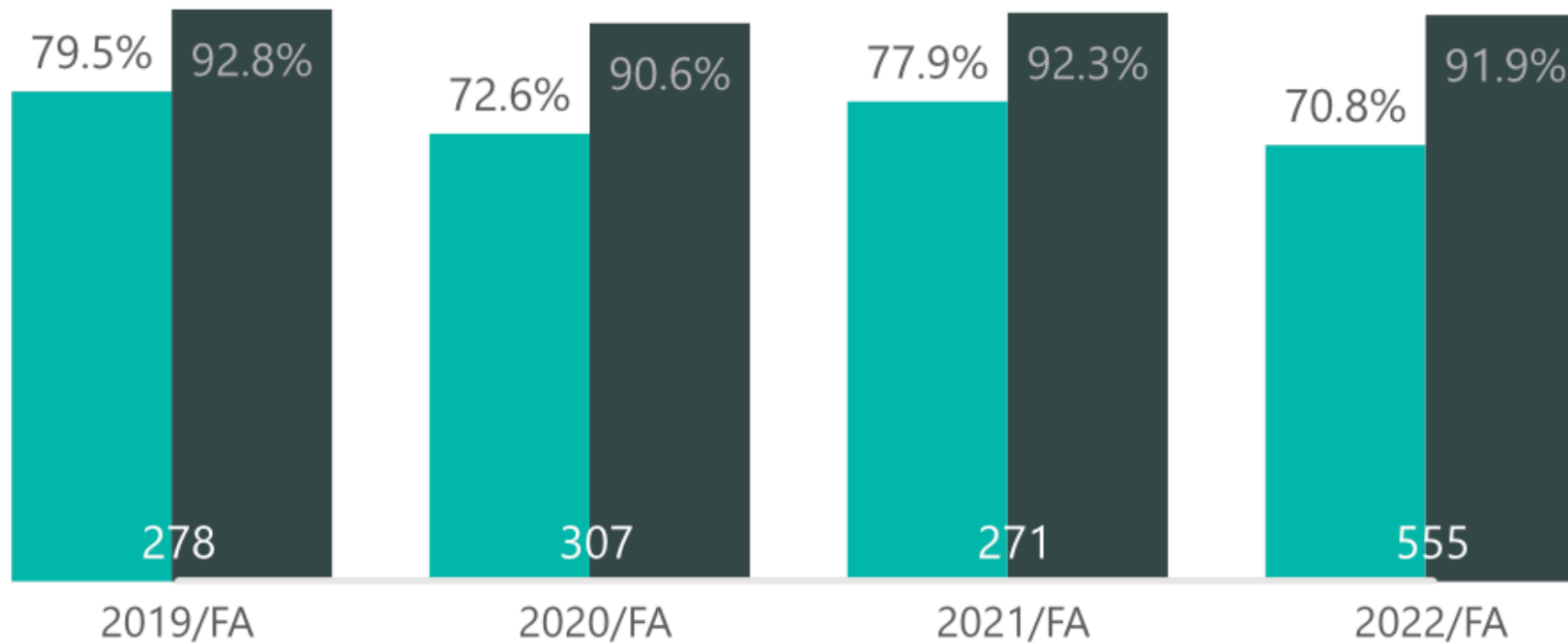

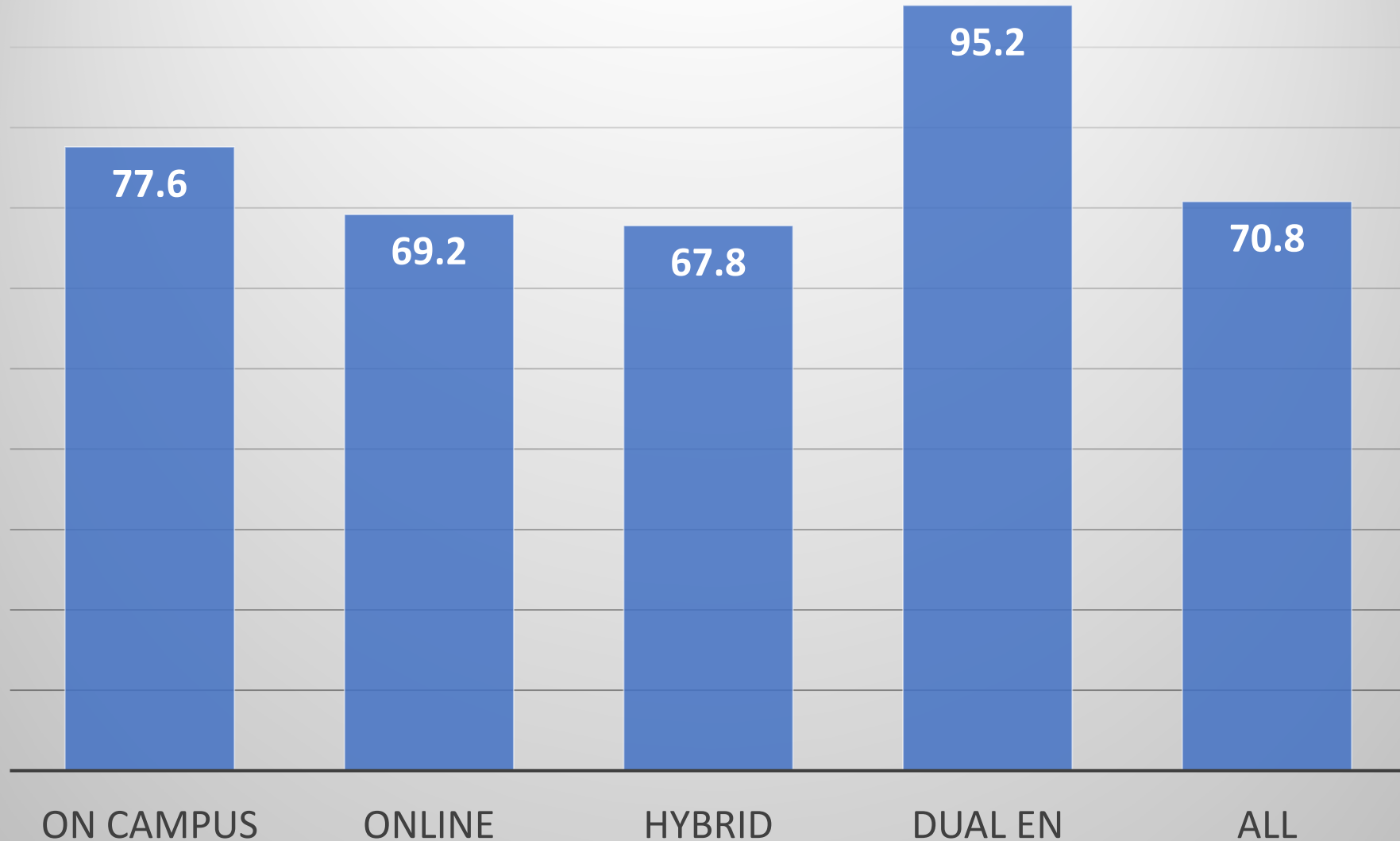
Four Year Course Success Trend

● Course Success ● Course Completion ● Enrollment

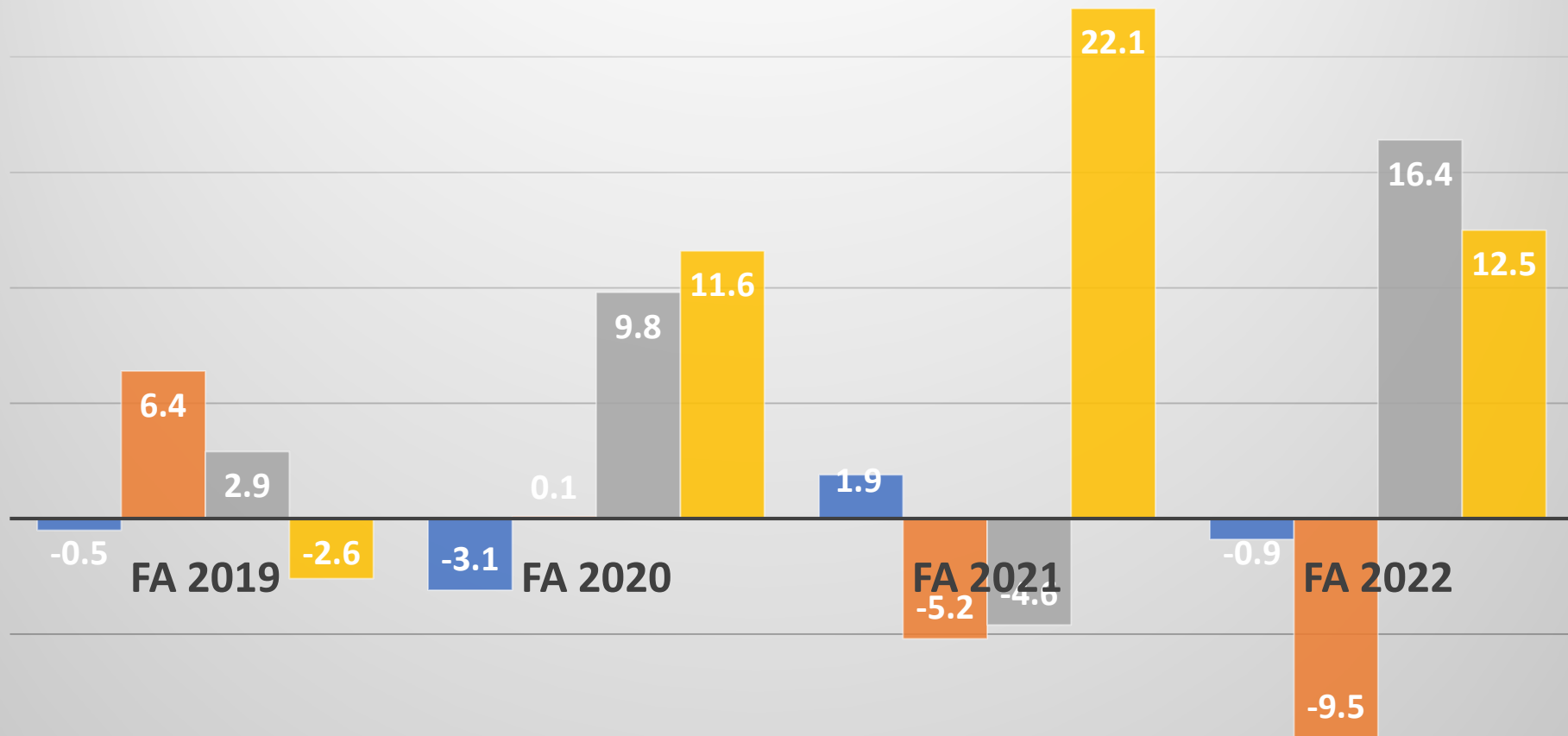
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Success by Modality – Ethnic Studies– Fall 2022

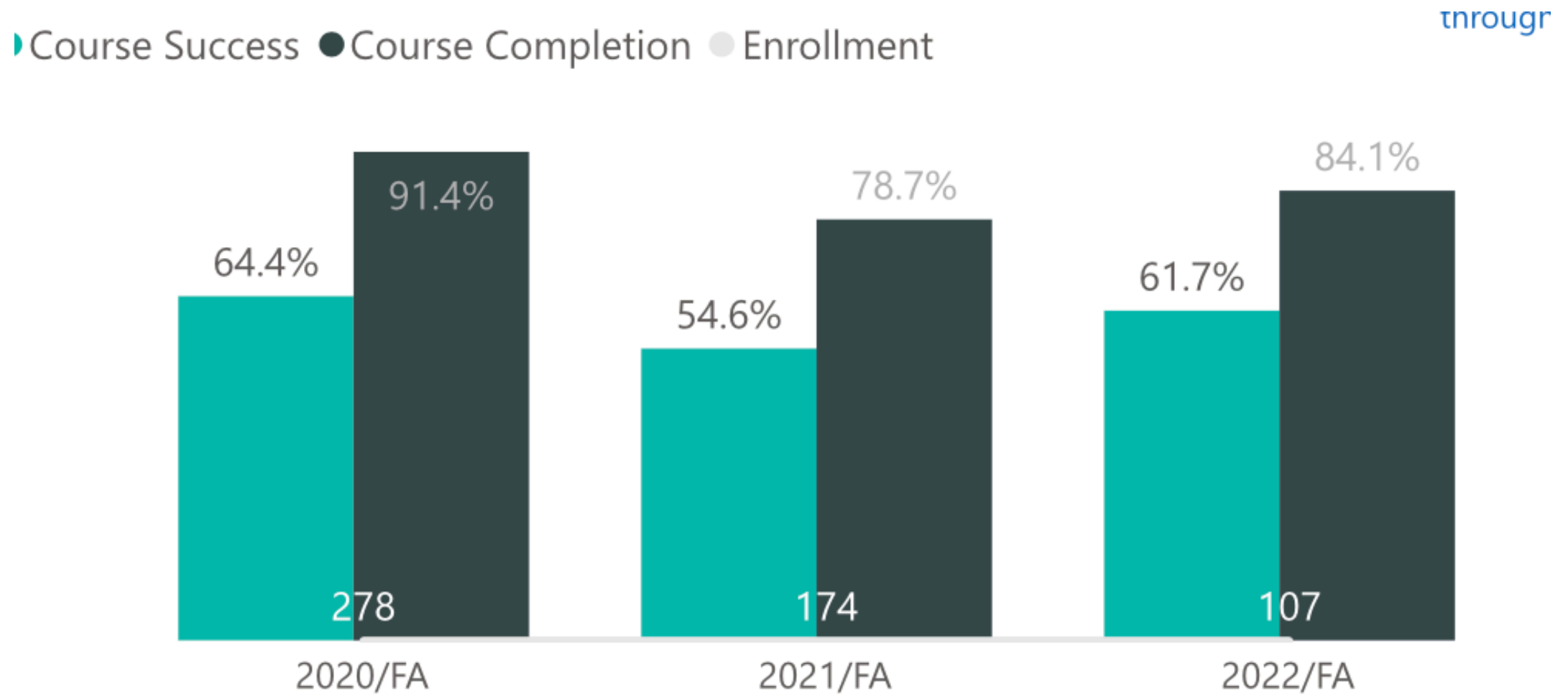


Success Gaps – Ethnic Studies – Fall 2019-2022

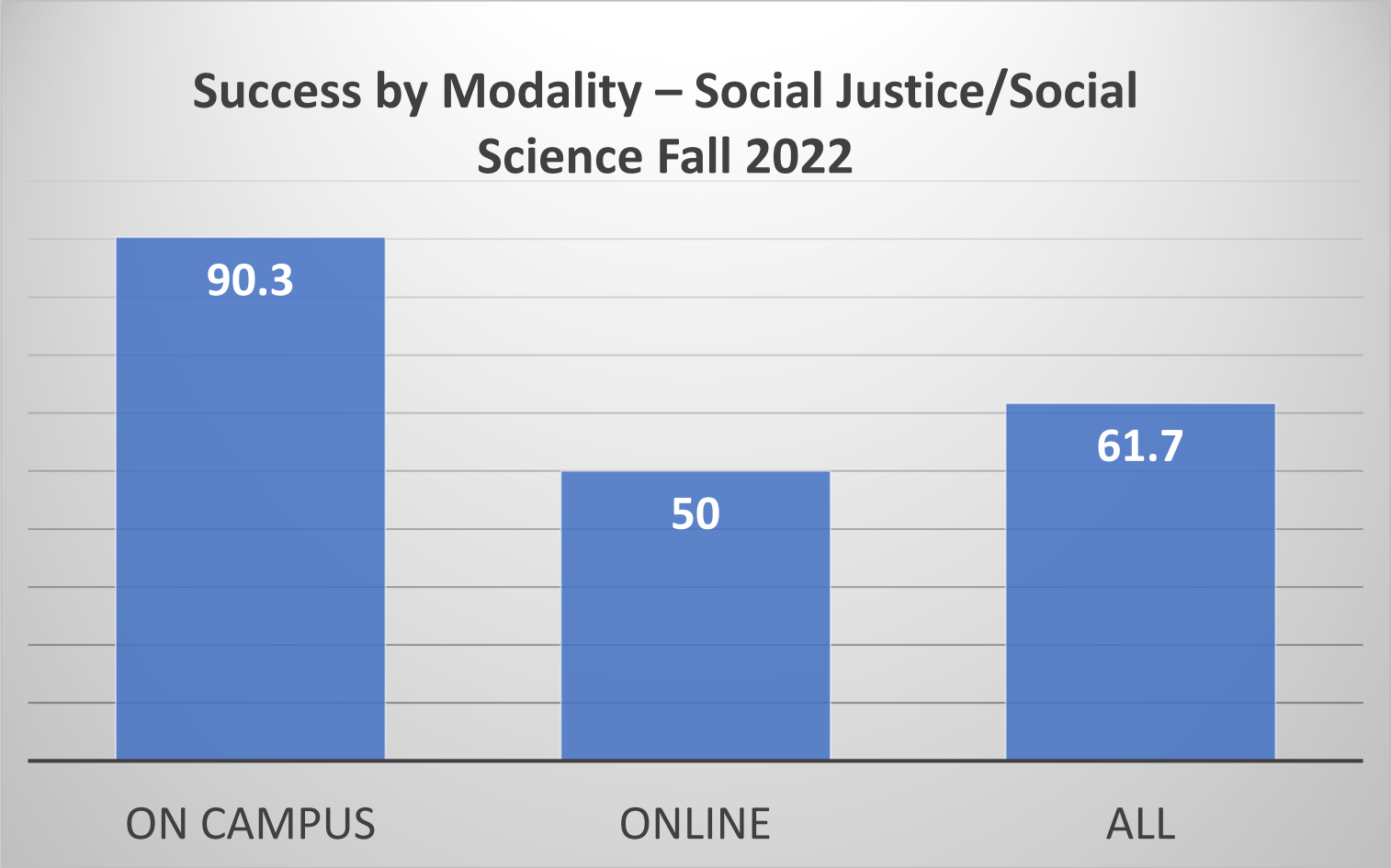

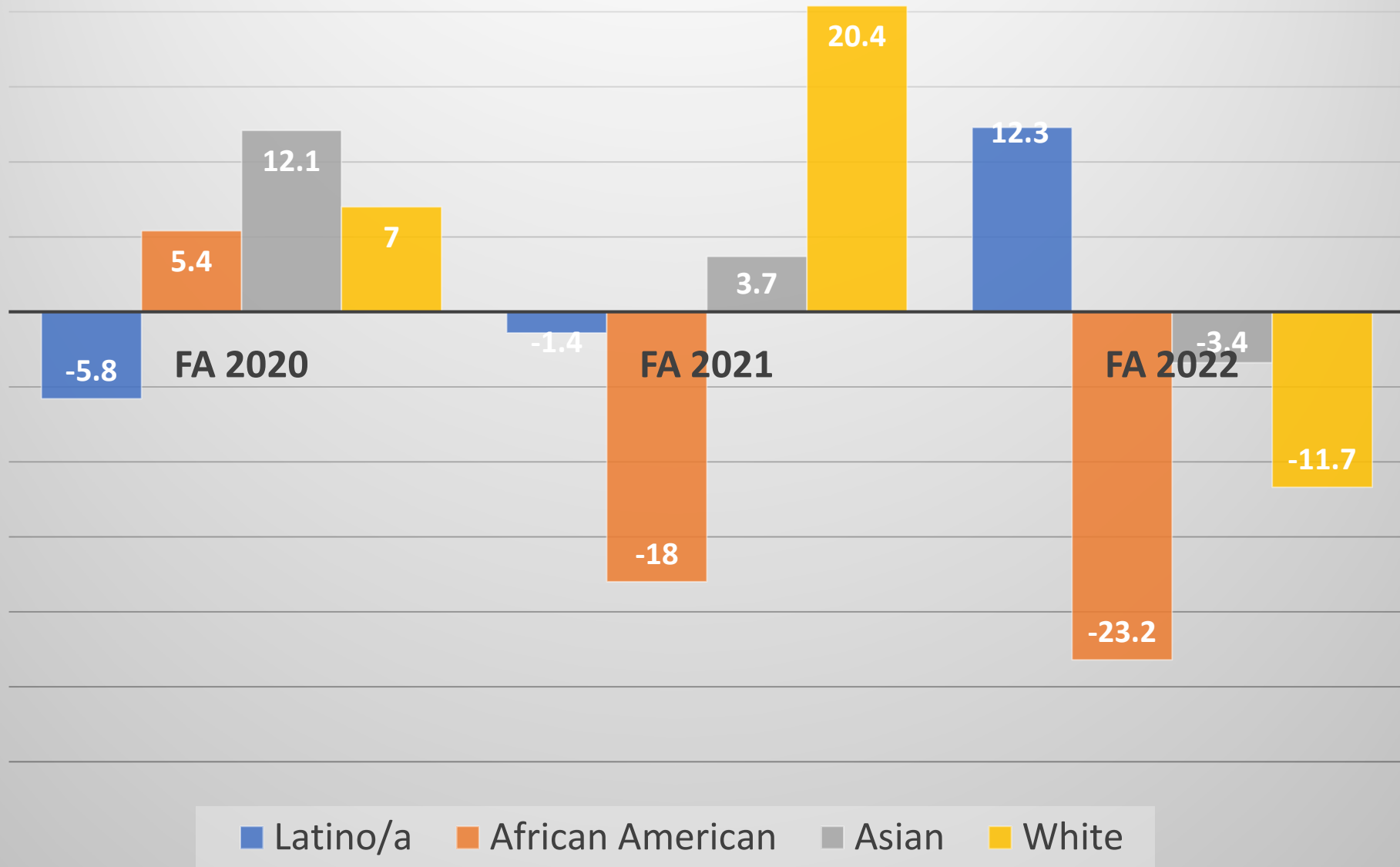
Social Science/Social Justice Studies, Success Rates 2020-23



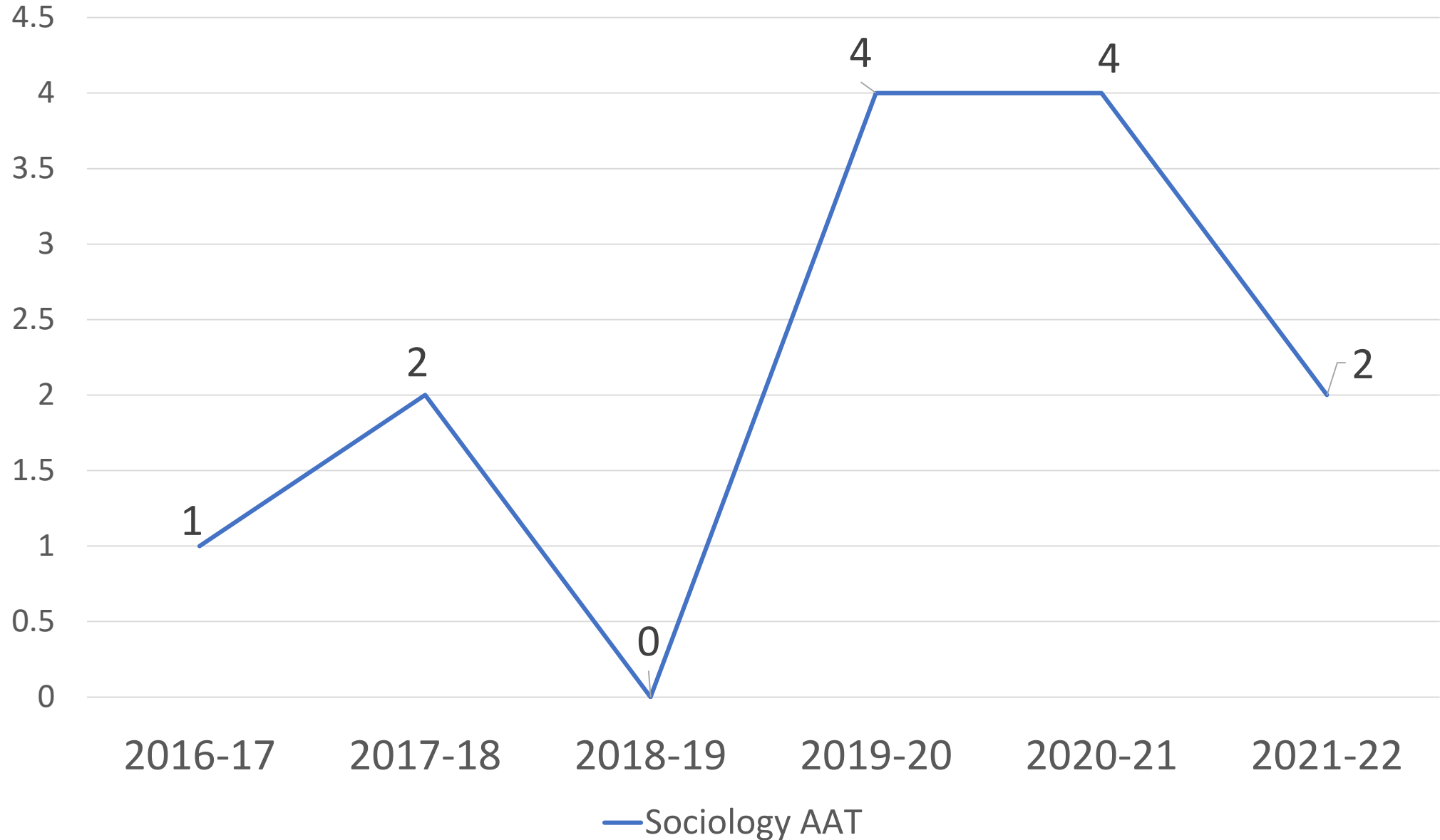
Social Science/Social Justice Studies, Success Rates 2020-23
