I) Counselor's Report – Paitzar Giourdjian (PowerPoint slides 3-6)

- The Transfer Center is holding a variety of events, in addition to in-person and virtual counseling hours. Of special interest is the Spring University Fair on March 23 from 11am-2pm. 40 Colleges and Universities will be there.
- The Career Center is holding a variety of workshops for undecided majors.
- See PowerPoint slide 5 for information about how students can schedule appointments with Counselors
- The first Tuesday of every month, BSS Counselors will be at a table between the SOCS and ARTB buildings for drop-in visits with students. Please let students know they are there.

II) New Social Sciences Building (PowerPoint slides 7-10)

- The estimated date the building will be completed is Sept. 1, 2023. After that, we may be able to move in during the Fall semester and begin instruction in the building in Winter or Spring 2024. This is contingent on no further delays, which is always a possibility.
- Division Council will be deciding on a process by which to distribute offices. Most likely, it will be by seniority.

III) Spring Schedule and Enrollment (PowerPoint slides 11-13)

- This Spring 2023 we are offering 5 more sections than last Spring 2022. This growth is to accommodate increasing enrollment, but also to make a variety of on campus and hybrid offerings available to students. (PP slide 13)
- In Spring 2022, 2 on campus sections filled to 40%, and 6 hybrid sections filled to 45%. This Spring 2023, 7 on campus sections filled to 42.5% and 2 hybrid sections filled to 83%. (PP slide 11)
- Students are returning to campus, but slowly.
- We will likely schedule fewer on campus sections since the fill rates are less than 50%.
- Overall, enrollment this Spring 2023 was up % from last Spring 2022.

IV) Sociology Student Success and Gap Data (PowerPoint slides 14-18)

- There is an overall decline in success rates for Sociology students (75.3% in Fall 2019 to 72.3% in Fall 2022). This reflects trends across the division and is likely a result of pandemic conditions and more online instruction.
- Success rates for Fall 2022 were 70.3% for online sections; on campus 77.6%; and hybrid 80%.
- Equity gap data shows a decline in the success gap from African American students in Fall 2022. This is especially good news given that the division as a whole has seen an increase in success gaps for African American students. (PP slide 16). The faculty noted this could be a result of losing struggling students.
- Sociology AAT awards have seen a slight decline during the pandemic from 143 in Spring 2020 to 124 in Spring 2022.
- Women's Studies success rates have also declined from 74.1% in Spring 2019 to 68.5% in Spring 2022. Equity gaps were large for African American students in Fall 2022. The course content has intersectionality baked in. It's possible the predominantly online offering of this course could be one cause. However, on campus sections are extremely low filled. Three students earned a Women, Gender and Sexuality Studies AA degree in 2021-22. The Dean encourages the development of an AAT. AAT degrees are better for transferring students and consequently more popular. Counselors tend to direct students to AATs.

V) Curriculum, SLOs, and Program Review

- Sociology 107H is a new course that will be available to offer in Fall 2024. In the meantime, we can offer SOCI 107 as an Honors course using a notation in the schedule.
- Fall assessments are complete.
- Kassia can offer workshops on Zoom for adjuncts to help with assessment. She used a google sheet to collect data.
- Kassia will reach out to SOCI 104 instructors to see if they are amenable to assessing on Canvas.

VI) Load Committee and Load Change Requests

- The load change requests for Sociology courses are still being negotiated.

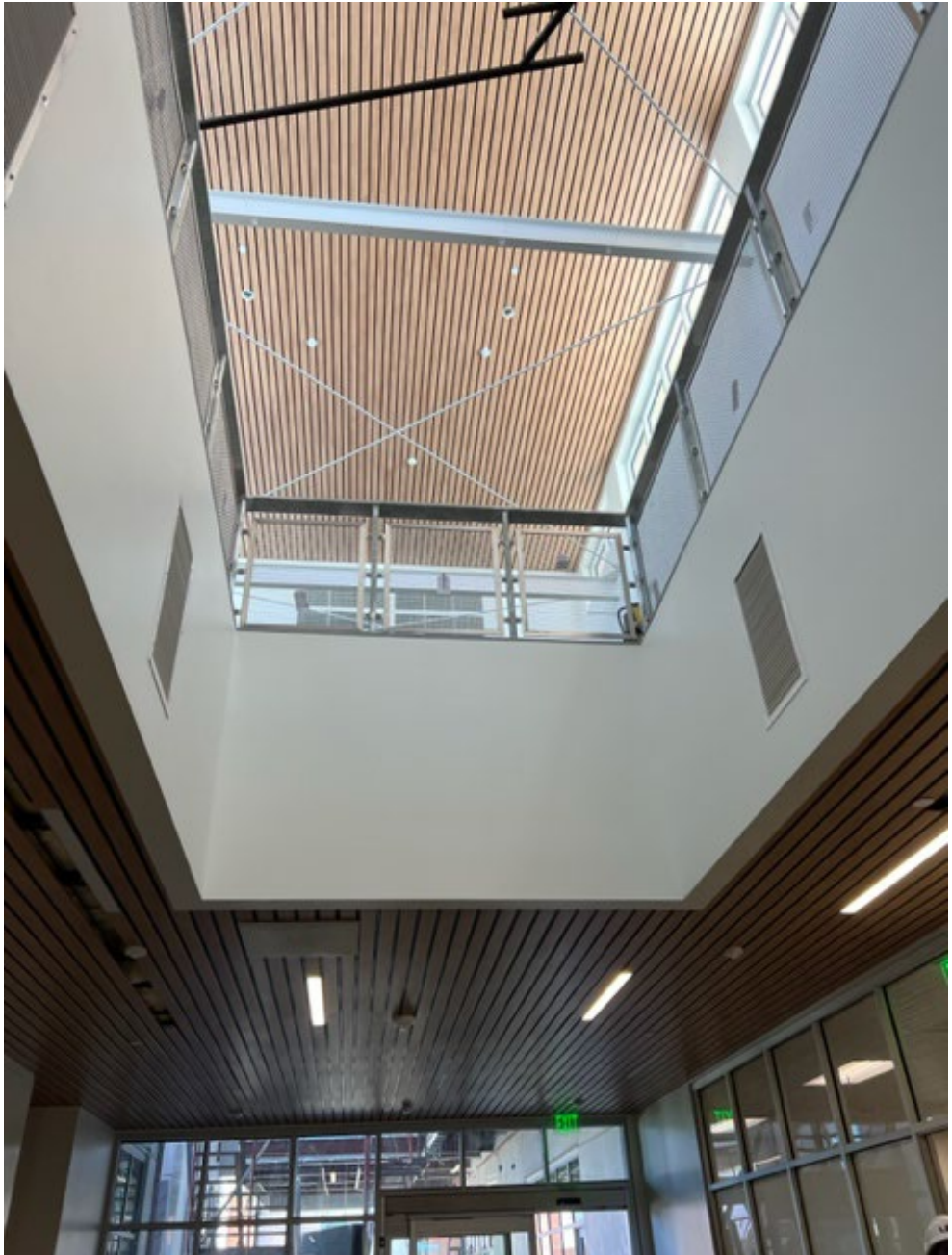

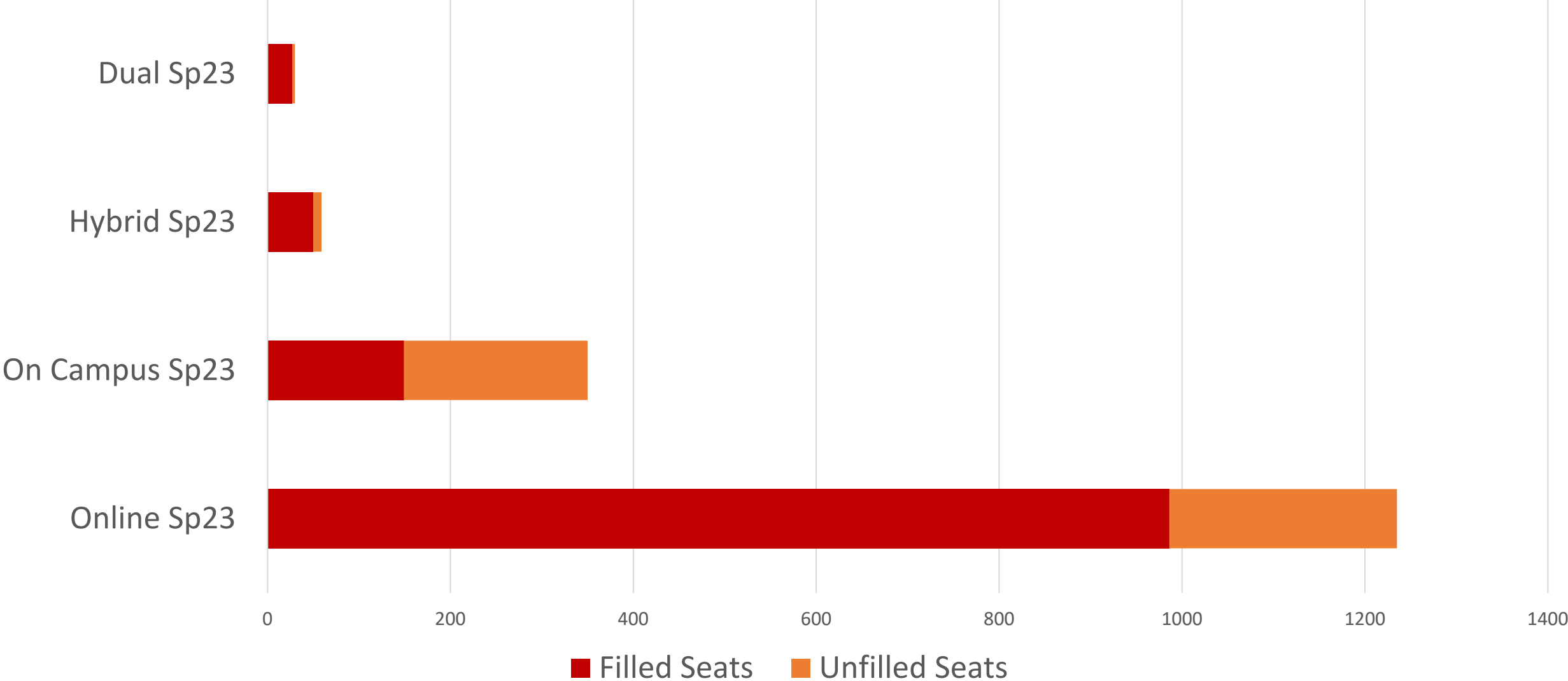

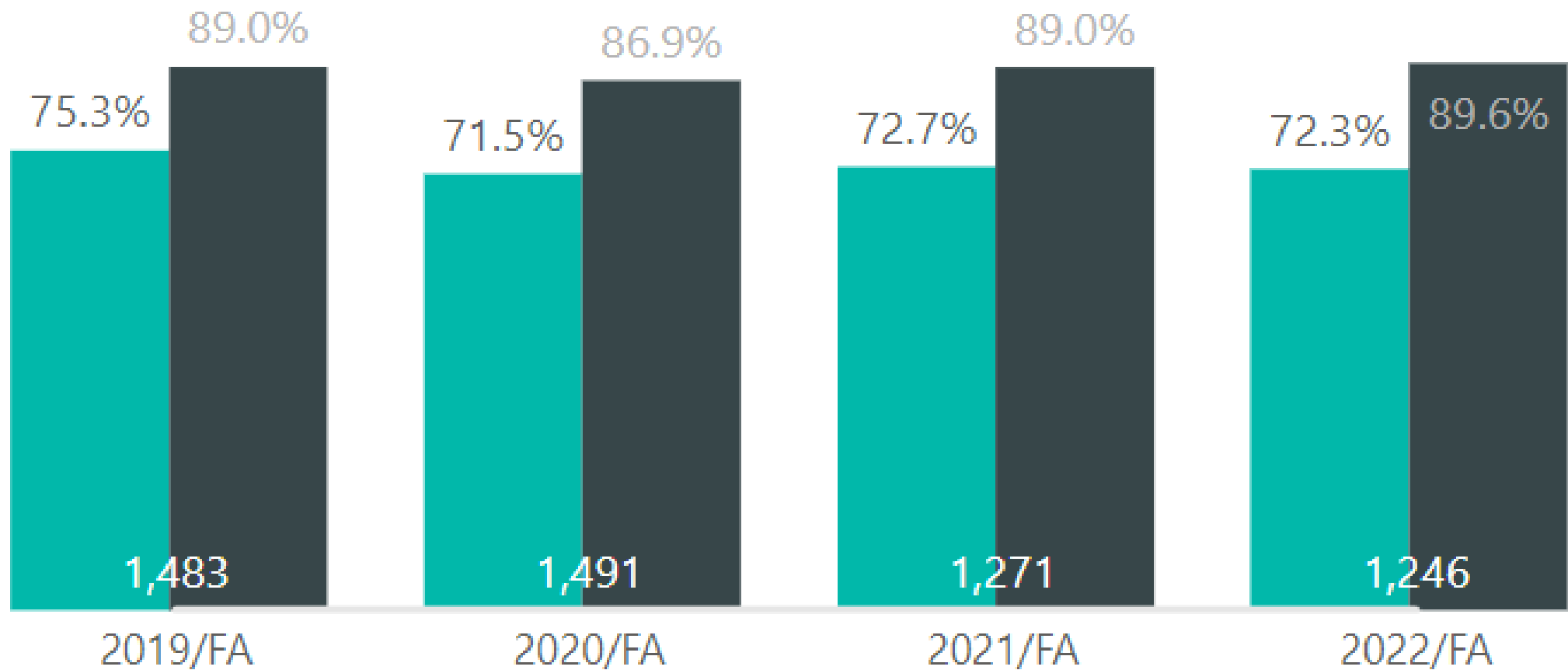

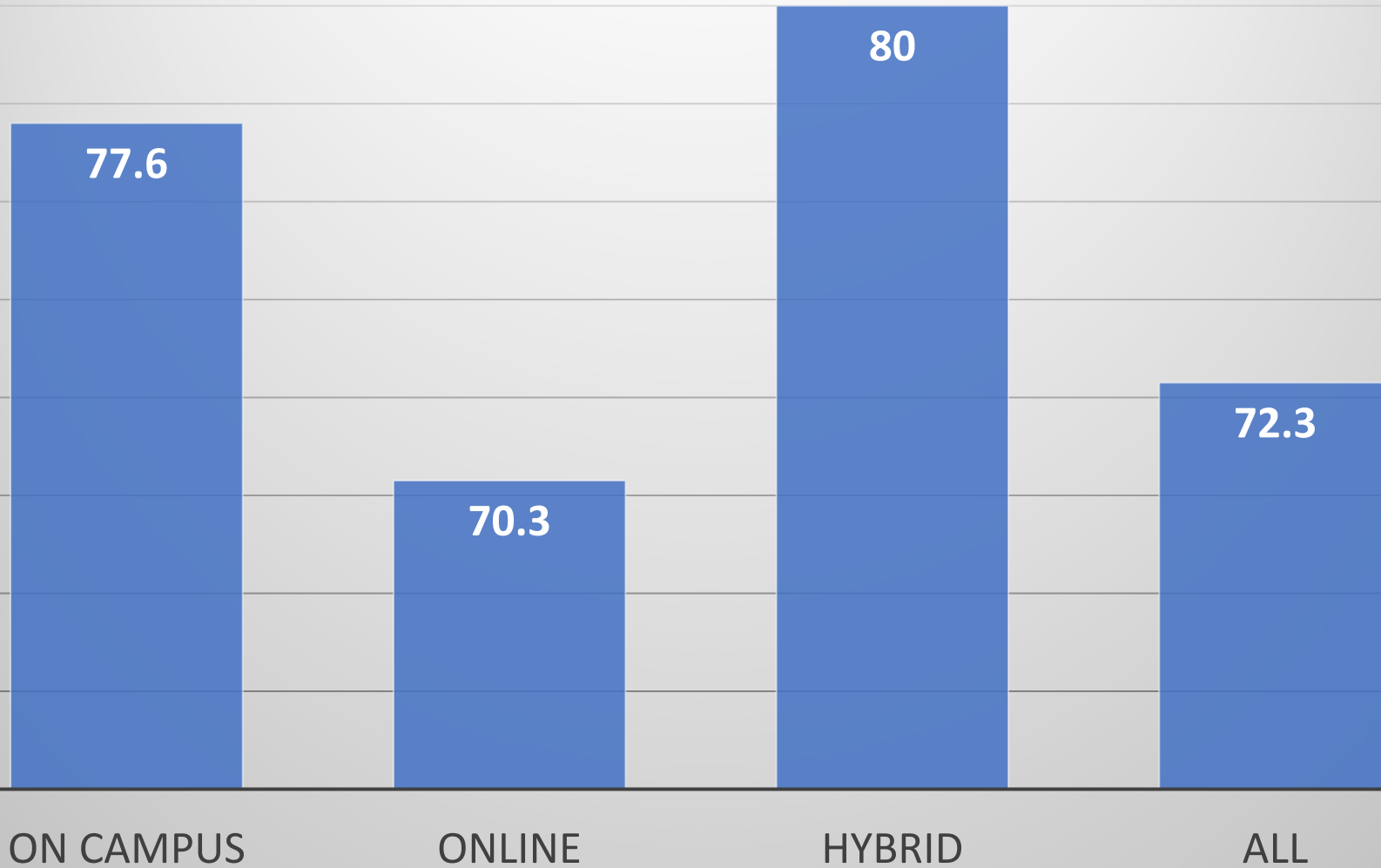
Four Year Course Success Trend

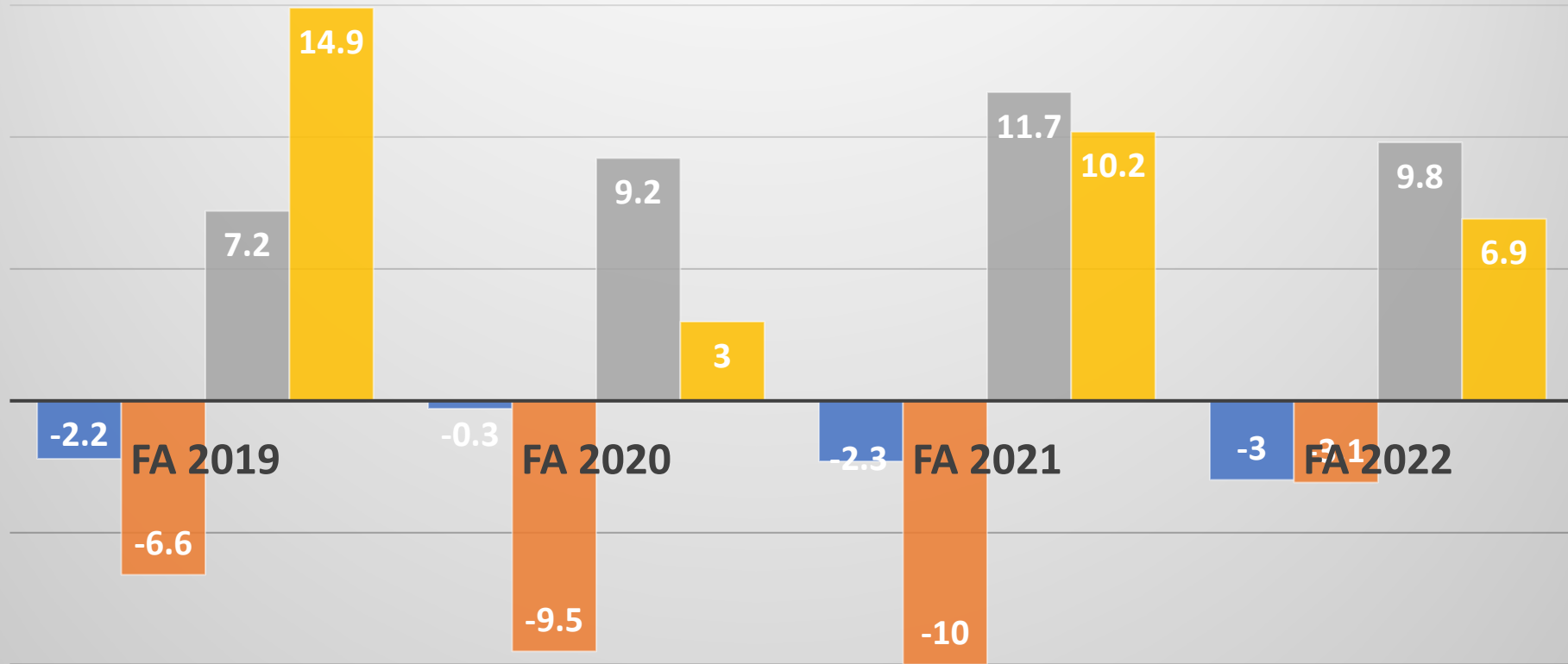

Success by Modality – Sociology– Fall 2022

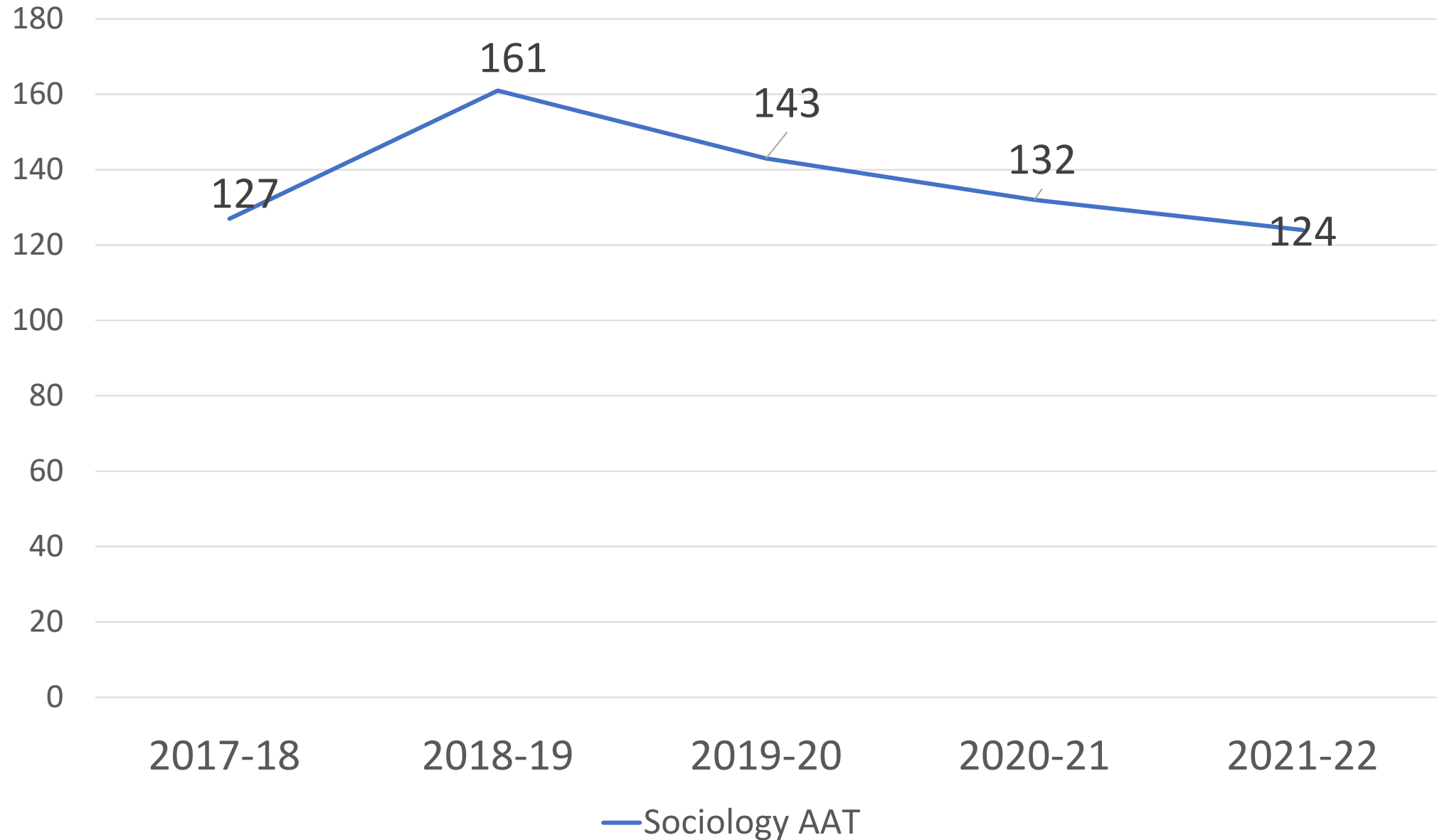


Success Gaps – Sociology– Fall 2019-2022

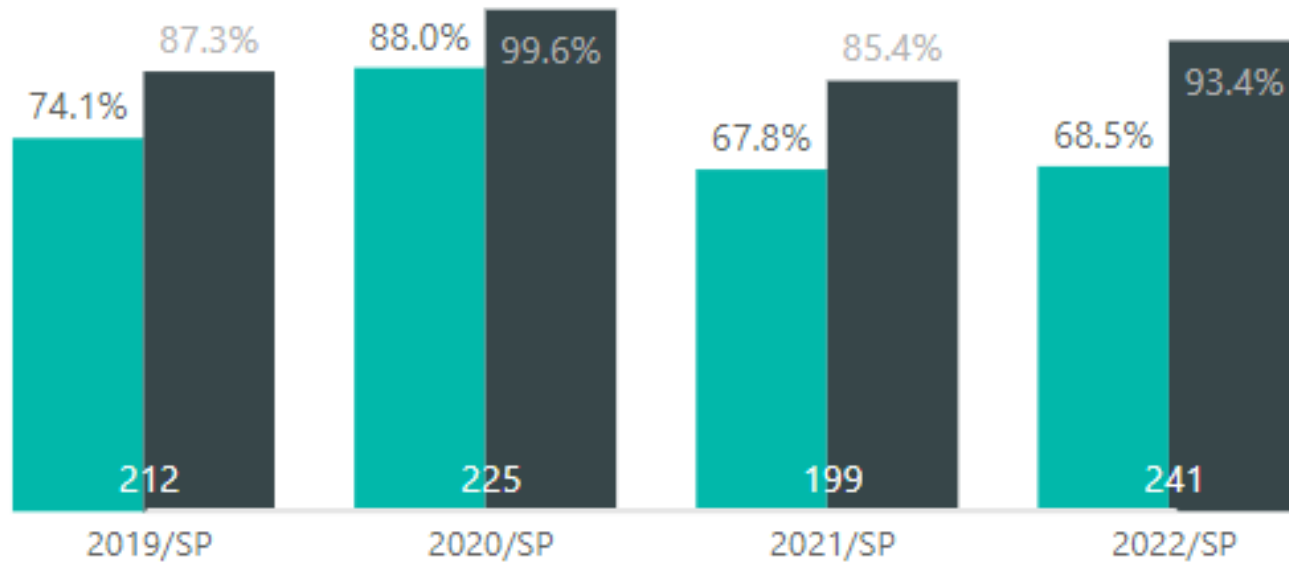

Four Year Course Success Trend

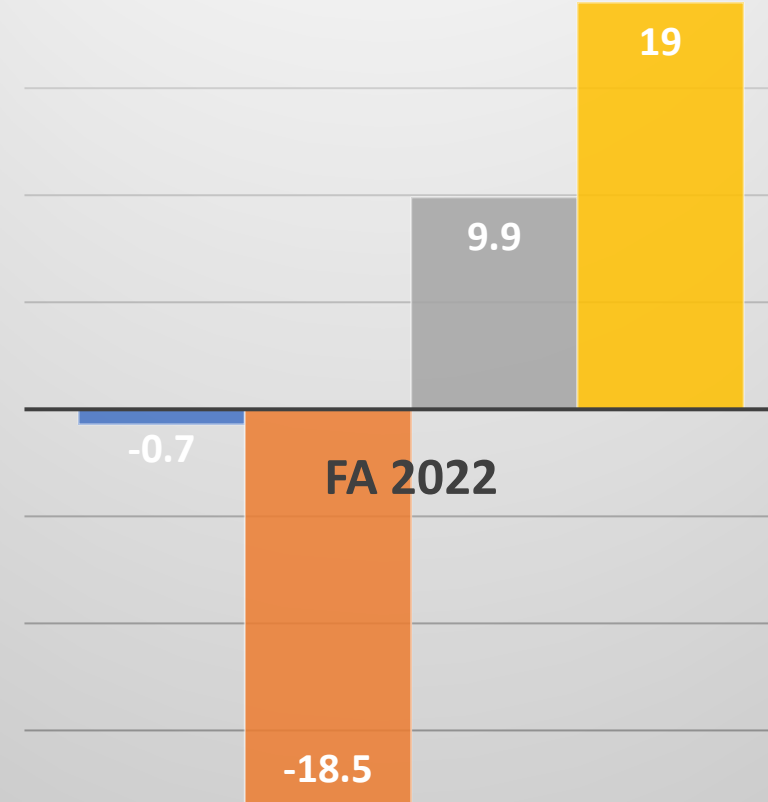
