S. Porter announced that review of the Accounting Certificate would be postponed until fall 2022.

R. Padilla shared a copy of the California State University (CSU) General Education Breadth 2021-2022.

It was noted that new course NCIS-42 is currently pending in Curriculog, due to an issue with Course Length. This course will be offered as an 8-week course; however, the system defaults to the standard 16-week course length. In the class schedule, the correct course length will be noted.
