
### **Associate in Arts Degree Program**

Students interested in Paralegal Studies are required to complete 18 units of general education coursework approved by the American Bar Association. Students transferring Associate's or Bachelor's degrees from other institutions must meet these requirements as well. Students transferring Bachelor's degrees from foreign institutions must request an evaluation for equivalency. Please consult with a Counselor for more information.
