- ✓ *Discussion of notes prior to upcoming presentation to Covid task force:*
 - *Add Oral Interpretation as they are also Theatrical in nature.*
 - *Light blue masks project voices much better than a cloth mask.*
 - *Limitations to being masked while performing on stage include limits to peripheral vision, interference with breathing, difficult to see, hard to project, etc.*
 - *“Theatrical performances” could include all on stage theatrical, dance, musical, and speech rehearsals and performances.*
