## **MINUTES**

#### I. Information/Announcements

A. Approval of Minutes from February 15, 2018 *Minutes from 2/15/18 were approved by the committee.* 

#### II. DISCUSSION/ACTIONS

#### A. Facilities

The final proposal is due to the state late spring for the Music and Theatre building. This proposal is the only project on campus that is eligible to receive matched funding from the state.

The committee has been selected for the Arts Complex which will house Film, Photo, Art and Dance. An invitation to vote for a faculty representative was sent by email to the departments that will be in the Arts Complex and Karen Whitney, Professor, Art was selected.

The committee reviewed architect proposals, met on 3/28/18 to score and selected 4 candidates for interview.

Jack Bay, Executive Director of Facilities will be fast tracking the installation of the AC units. All conduits have been installed and electrical updated. Once installation of AC is complete, we can move forward with the updating the rooms to have smart room capabilities.

42,000 s.f. of space has been allocated to Fine Arts for our lecture classes. Lecture classes to be held would be Coms, Art History, Art Appreciation and Photo lecture classes.

## B. Fine Arts Fair & Panels

For future Fine Arts fairs, the faculty would like more advance notice and more consultation. Panels for Theatre were poorly attended due to lack of notice.

Music Panel was well attended.

Some departments find that they have better results when bringing in speakers from different schools during their class meeting time.

- HS matinee (c.50 minutes) without all large group live performances
- Evening (c.80 minutes) with costs for both covered by low price tickets or possibly ASB

- Video presentations (about 5' for each discipline):

  - o Acting scene(s)
  - o Public Speaking/Oral Interpretation/Debate...
  - o Classical instrumental ensemble Band section this year (future full in Marsee)
  - o Jazz group Concert or Studio (alternate years?)
  - o Choral group(s)
  - o Applied music student numbers (if needed/time)
