MINUTES

I. INFORMATION/ANNOUNCEMENTS

A. Approval of Minutes from 10/31/17

Minutes were approved with a correction. Deadline of 12/1/18 was changed to 12/1/17.

B. Faculty Position Identification

The President approved the top 22 positions which gave Fine Arts approval to move forward with a position description for a full-time Theatre faculty.

II. DISCUSSION/ACTIONS

A. 2017/18 Department Plans due 12/7/17

There is no limit to the amount of items that your dept can submit for ranking. Art had broken its area up into 5 sub-areas to cover needs for Art History, 3D, Painting, Design and Digital. Although the department may have more items to submit than smaller departments such as film or photo, the same consideration for ranking will be made.

The deadline to submit your top priorities to Lori Yamasaki is 12/4/17. You are asked to break down your submissions by category (facilities, staffing, instructional equipment or software/hardware)



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B. Building Adjustments Draft II

The following building adjustments will move forward for Fall 2018:

- ✓ *Dance will use AUD-130 on MW 1-2:45pm until new Art building is constructed.*
- ✓ *Voice and Opera Workshop will be moved to Musi-134 with minimal changes to the schedule.*
- ✓ *Film lec classes will move to Musi-7 and may incur some schedule changes.*
- ✓ *We will continue to reserve Musi-7 for Applied Music and some master classes on Thursdays from 11am-2pm.*

The following were submitted to Division Council for consideration:

- ✓ *Coms classes and Forensics to be moved to Musi-131 & 133.
**Coms department supports this recommendation.*
- ✓ *Divider between Musi-204 and 205 will be opened to create one large open space for acting classes with ample storage for their costumes and props. Could possibly house Pilates classes as they need a space to house their equipment.
**Thea department does not support this recommendation and would like to remain in Musi-6. Additionally, they are requesting additional space for the new FT hire in FA/18.*
- ✓ *If stagecraft is moved, Thea-151 could be used for Film classes.
**Thea department supports this recommendation.*
- ✓ *Bill and Kevin are working to alleviate sound leakage that comes from the door of Musi-6 & 7, moving acting classes to 204/205 will allow Film the ability to use this room as shooting space.
**Theatre department does not support this recommendation and voice concern over Film courses being offered in Musi-7 during the time their acting classes are scheduled.*

Additionally, the division is working with academic affairs analyst to re-configure end times of Piano, Voice and Guitar classes so that they all end at the same time. This will free up more space in our classrooms and allow us to schedule more classes at prime times.

III. OTHER

New art building could include dance studios, art labs, film, photo and art gallery. Behavior and Social Science building will house all of our lecture courses. As we are in the early stages this may change. Building names will be addressed when we have confirmation of our layout.
