- 3. **Lecture/Lab hours**: make sure the breakdown has been updated since Curricuware)
- 4. **Objectives**: Assessments selected
- 5. **Evaluation Methods and Assignments**: make sure Primary evaluation method matches Typical assignment
- 6. **Textbook**: required edition not more than 5 years old
- 7. **C-IDs**: check at c-id.net/descriptors.html
- 8. Any changes in contact hours, units, prerequisites, or other areas of significance need to be discussed with the dean.

The committee identified areas of review that need to be checked by DCC reps before faculty submit course proposals to the DCC. In addition to the above list, the committee identified "Conditions of Enrollment" and "Entry Skills."
