I. INFORMATION/ANNOUNCEMENTS

- A. Minutes from February 21, 2017

II. DISCUSSION/ACTIONS

A. Standard Reviews

- Art 141, 144, 146 need to do standard reviews.
- Art 142 was one on the Chancellor level to remove the prerequisite but it never came back. W. Cox will follow-up on this.

- COMS wants to reactivate the Certificate. They will need to write a
 justification and follow the same process as when it was first created. There is
 no Top Code for COMS so it cannot be CTE.
- The committee should have received a notice to vote on some CTE reviews.
- J. Dallal has sent Art 247 to the counselors but has not gotten a response. W. Cox will follow-up on this.

B. New Proposals

- J. Dallal will submit new proposals for upper level courses.
- For new proposals, if approved will be offered in 1 year (Fall 2018)
- W. Georges is inserting a survey. The department needs to develop an advisory committee to assist with curriculum.
- World Dance the department will revamp the course. L. Adams will be focusing on the Dance Certificate first then will focus on revamping the World Dance course.
- P. Chambers-Salazar is still working on Music 101. She plans to start over. The committee discussed wording that may assist with the approval of the course.

III. OTHER

- The committee discussed the issue of students not having enough units to get an AA when doing the AA-T program.
- It was suggested that we start working on Credit by Exam courses.
- Another suggestion was to having students submit substitution of course petitions to help meet AA requirements.
