2. SLO BUSINESS

- 2.1. Elise reminded faculty that the English 1B and 1C Consistency Projects, which include SLO assessments, are underway this semester.
- 2.2. Elise discussed the new recommendation from the college SLO coordinators that each course have three SLOs. While an exact number of SLOs might not be appropriate for all courses, the faculty agreed to work with the worksheet designed by Elise and Stephanie Merz that asks faculty to consider the current SLO statement(s) and the course objectives. Faculty are also asked to consider common SLO-aligned assessment tools and rubrics for each course.
- 2.3. Kevin shared his expertise in the area of multiple SLOs being assessed via a "common" assessment tool and shared models of the same. He also discussed the simplification of the assessment process in order to both increase meaningfulness and decrease "busy work."
