- A. ITS has informed us that we will likely need to go down to one computer lab in the division. The decision about Chem-108 or LS-134 hasn't been made yet.

- C. I have a walk-through of our facilities with environmental consultants regarding in-person fall labs. I will report out about important information.

- E. Facilities will upgrade the ventilation in the entire division. That will cost >\$6 million, and should take a year to complete. They have also spent \$1.8 million to install HEPA air filters and uv lights in the vents.
- F. Counseling would like to know if Chem-4 from other institutions can be accepted for the prereq for Chem-1A. A poll of the department indicates that yes, the Chem-4 equivalent will now be accepted from other schools for the Chem-1A prerequisite. Amy will alert Counseling of the change.
